Items of Business:

1. Sheri Suave, District Rep.
 - Profile of a 3rd grade Student

Melissa took notes on a document specifically sent by Sheri.

2. Principal Report
 - • Review Data for Current Year Goals
 1. We are on track with our budget.
 2. Renewed the Affinity License
 3. Pay teachers half stipend for collaborative meetings including math standards, language arts needs, SEL curriculum, etc. This stipend is to compensate for losing some prep time.
 4. Power BI: Access to data for students and teachers-fantastic assessment tool
 1. Acadience data: Pathways of progress-70% of students k-3 making typical or better progress at end of year. Where are they scoring through progress monitoring and benchmarks. We hope students are making typical or higher than typical progress. Helps us identify gaps in learning. Last year 73.4% of students at or above typical progress. We are now at 65.5% typical progress MOY. Our goal is to hit 77% at EOY. Teachers have analyzed data and made action plans to inform their instruction for the remainder of the school year.
 5. Also, mixed grade teams are working on reading comprehension, math, science, SEL, Fine Arts, Social Studies, and STEM goals that will have viewable data at the end of the school year.
 6. Funding for next year: \$20,000 decrease in funding due to Oct. 1 count and less students enrolled in Face-to-face school. Kids have come back from Davis Connect and increased our numbers but this was after the Oct. 1 count.
 7. Principal Lowry shared a DRAFT of proposed goals for Teacher Student Success Plan-the above mentioned areas all have draft goals.

8. Concern from teachers about how to use the Trust Lands money efficiently to maximize the resource for highly trained professionals within the school to support the DRAFT goals.
9. Robotics discussion about funding.
10. Side-note: Parents are welcome to volunteer in the school.
