Responsible to:	Head of Physiotherapy
Job Purpose:	The Graduate Physiotherapist will be responsible for supporting the rehabilitation and development of pupils aged 13 to 18

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

PHYSIO:

- To support the Head of Physiotherapy in the day to day running of the physiotherapy clinic.
- To provide a high standard of evidenced based medical treatment and rehabilitation of pupils.
- Assessment and rehabilitation of all injuries.
- Pitch side physiotherapy across multiple sports.
- To help develop prehabilitation strategies and personalised programmes to reduce the risk of injury in athletic populations.
- To communicate effectively within the teaching, coaching and pastoral community.
- To attend training sessions as appropriate.
- To undertake, analyse and feedback on movement screening protocols.
- To keep all documentation and medical notes up to date.
- To engage in day to day administration, communications and diary management.
- To be flexible in your role to meet the requirements of your job.
- To perform any other duties that your line manager sees fit providing that such duties are appropriate to your role.
- To contribute to the boarding programme at Millfield School
- You may also be required to provide supervision for pupils using the gym on Sunday afternoons (additional remuneration will be provided).

PASTORAL:

As part of this role you will be required to provide support to the boarding programme. Depending on allocated accommodation you will either be required to do boarding duties within a year 9 boarding house or on campus duties.

Duty Times in a Year 9 Boarding House:

- Two duty nights per week (typically 6.00pm to 10.00pm) for the whole academic year.
- Weekend duties on rotation with the house team, as directed by Housemaster/mistress.

Duties in a Year 9 Boarding House:

- To provide duty supervision in the year 9 House allocated



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- To ensure that the House is run smoothly and efficiently in line with the House and School guidelines
- To keep open lines of communication with Housemaster/mistress and Assistant Housemaster/mistress with regards any matter affecting the House
- To provide general support for the Housemaster/mistress, examples of which include; assistance during parents' day and the first day of the school year, occasional House trips, barbeques, Christmas and other dinners and help during emergencies
- Being available to pupils, supporting them, and socialising with them at various times to ensure they always feel they have an adult to turn to.
- Assist on the planning and delivery of the Year 9 Outdoor Education programme, as directed by the Director of Outdoor Activities.

Duty Times for on Campus Duties

- Three nights per week (typically 8.30pm – 9.45pm) for the whole academic year.
- One weekend in three supporting boarding houses with social activities. Either a Saturday night or Sunday daytime.

On Campus Duties

- Supervision of post prep campus activities i.e. the gym, track and astropitches

PERSON SPECIFICATION:

- Background: Degree in Physiotherapy, Sport Rehabilitation or Sport Therapy.
- Experience: 0-3 years; prior experience and underpinning knowledge of working in a physiotherapy environment with young athletes will be beneficial.
- Experience: previous experience of coaching movement skills in group and individual settings will be beneficial.
- Comfortable working with a multidisciplinary team.
- Hard working and a 'go getter' attitude.
- High level of inter personal skills and confident IT user.
- Open to new ideas and experiences.

THE GRADUATE PHYSIOTHERAPIST WILL BE:

- Committed to developing and instilling excellence in young people.
- Able to engage and motivate young people in sports practices and foster an enjoyment and understanding of athletic training.
- Able to display and instil strong and inspiring leadership qualities.
- Motivated and self-driven to develop themselves in their chosen career. Millfield will support CPD opportunities on review with the Head of Physiotherapy.
- Contributing positively to weekly graduating meetings and specific sports meetings.
- A strong team player, capable of integrating their own ideas with those in a broader organisational environment.
- Capable of planning and delivering against identified goals.
- Embracing of Millfield's broad environment and approach to all-round education.
