

Diversity, Equity & Inclusion (DEI) Committee Application

Gull Lake Community Schools (GLCS) is committed to ensuring that all students reach their fullest potential. In pursuit of this mission, the District is working to form the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Committee with the goal of improving cultural awareness, diversity, equity, and inclusion in the GLCS district. The Committee will work to identify and recommend areas for improvement related to DEI strategies district-wide to the Curriculum Committee of the Gull Lake Board of Education. The DEI Committee will be composed of members of The Gull Lake Board of Education and diverse members of the GLCS including administrators, staff, teachers, parents, students, and individuals from the community.

The District is looking for individuals interested in serving on the DEI committee. Ideally, individuals will possess the following skills and characteristics:

Team Oriented: The committee will be composed of approximately 20 members of diverse identities, cultures, races, genders, and life experiences. Team members should have the ability to exercise empathy and build strong trust, collaboration, and communication among diverse identities.

Self-Reflective: Ability to address one's own personal prejudices/biases and participate in discussion around diversity, equity, and inclusion.

Project Management: Possess skills to help move planning forward in terms of implementation, management, and communication.

Ability to Listen to Other Perspectives and Opinions: Ability to listen actively, creatively, and reflectively. In order to work together and promote a sense of trust and camaraderie, this ability is necessary so that members can share personal experiences and feel heard and supported.

Commitment: Willingness to volunteer time over multiple years. Committee members will have a 2-year term (approximately 4 hours/month). Student Committee members are required to commit for 3-consecutive trimesters.
