Dual Credit/PSEO Parent Information

Definitions

- Dual Credit (DC): A student takes a course through a college and receives high school and college credit simultaneously.
- PSEO: Post-Secondary Enrollment Options
 - A state program for MN residents that pay for the dual credit class.
 - Note: Non-MN residents can take DC courses, but must pay the tuition.

Academic Requirements

- SCLA requires students to have an ACT (or Pre-ACT) composite score of 20 or higher to be eligible for dual credit courses.
- SCLA will also determine if students are eligible for dual credit courses based on a variety of factors, including academic ability and history of missing work.
- Some institutions have additional requirements of applicants.

Taking courses

- Juniors: Online (must be asynchronous)
 - Must be electives
 - Core course exemption
- Seniors: Online (asynchronous) or on campus if fulltime.
 - Can take a DC core course.
 - Can be full-time, but must take Religion 12.
- Popular schools

Getting courses into the SCLA schedule

- Sign up for all SCLA courses.
- Fill out the DC/PSEO plan for 1st and 2nd sem and submit for approval.
- Once registered for the course(s), provide a screenshot of registration to Rathje and then a Academic Study Hall will be substituted.

Things Parents Should Know

- College-level rigor.
- Grades are permanent.
- Schools will not contact you.
 - Be "in the know"
- 2nd semester registration warning.
- Not all students are ready— and that is OK.
- School-Life balance.
- Future financial aid implications

Rathje's Recommendations

- Students should take an AP course before attempting a college course.
- # of courses: 1, 2, or 4.
- Carefully evaluate commitments outside of school.
- "Trust, but verify."

What do I do?

- Fill out the Dual Credit/PSEO Plan form and give it to Dr. Rathje for approval by April 15. If PSEO, fill out the PSEO Registration form also. Forms are available in the Academic Office.
- 2. When your plan is approved by Dr. Rathje, follow the directions of the institution for enrollment, and meet the deadlines from the MN Department of Education PSEO website.
- 3. Complete step 1 by APRIL 15. Students who miss the April 15 deadline will not be able to participate in dual credit/PSEO for the 21-22 school year.
- 4. Once accepted by the institution, register for the approved class(es) and then provide proof of registration (screenshot or email) to Dr. Rathje and your SCLA schedule will be adjusted.
 - Application > Registration

Dates to Remember:

- March 12: ACT registration deadline for 4/17 test.
- April 15: DC/PSEO Plan deadline.
- April 17: Last ACT test date to qualify.
- June 4: Confirmation of course registration due.
