## CONTRACTS

Pick exactly which days you want for the entire summer (pricing is listed per-day). There is a 20 day minimum required.

*Additional days added after the commitment date will be considered a drop-in and will be charged at the drop-in tuition rate for each section.*

Same Day "All Day" Drop-in Rate (Requires Active Contract)	\$46.00
Same Day "PT" Drop-In Rate (Requires Active Contract)	\$30.00
PT Rate AM 7:30 AM - 12:00 PM	\$20.00
PT Rate PM 12:00 PM - 4:30 PM	\$20.00
All Day Rate 7:30 AM - 4:30 PM	\$36.00

*There are no scholarships for families during the summer months. County assistance may be available for qualifying families; contact your county of residence to determine eligibility.*



## REGISTRATION & PAYMENTS

Registration completed by 3/16/21 requires a non-refundable registration fee of \$25 per student contract. Registration completed after 3/16/21 increases to \$35 per student contract. SPOT may begin a waitlist at any point based on site size limits.

**Before Commitment Deadline  
5/19/21, 11:59 PM**

Families may drop and add days based on availability without a change fee. Some dates may fill and may not be available due to staffing ratios or pod sizes.

**After Commitment Deadline 5/19/2021**

Families may cancel days for a fee if notice is received by Wednesday 11:59 pm prior to the affected week. The cancellation fee is \$15 per child for each email (regardless of the number of days requested). Requests must be made to [CECares@District279.org](mailto:CECares@District279.org). Days cannot be canceled under the 20 day minimum.

Days may be added at the "All Day" Drop-In Rate of \$46.00 per day or at the "PT" Drop-In Rate of \$30.00 per day. Adding days is based on a space availability basis by entering it in the registration system by Wednesday 11:59 pm prior to the week attending.

- No swapping or banking of days are allowed.

Contracts entered after May 19<sup>th</sup> are not guaranteed placement when summer begins on June 17<sup>th</sup> and are subject to space availability. An email notification will be given when your contract is accepted.
