
Digital Recording 1 and 2

DR 1:

- Use Audacity and GarageBand software.
- Use microphones, loops, and MIDI keyboard to create professional quality digital recordings.


DR 2:

- Use Logic Pro music production software.
- Use a drum machine, microphones, loops, and
 MIDI keyboard to create professional quality
 digital recordings.
- Learn mixing/mastering techniques.




Guitar Lab

- Designed for the student with little or no experience playing the guitar
- Prepare for a lifetime of guitar playing and music appreciation
- Learn to play melodies and chords on the electric guitar using fingerstyle and picking techniques
- Perform solo and ensemble literature in a variety of musical styles and read standard music notation




Piano Lab (Musicianship I)

- Designed for the student with little or no experience playing the piano.
- Learn to play melody and chords on the piano keyboard.
- Learn to read standard music notation in treble/bass clef.




Basic Music Theory (Musicianship II)

- Learn how to write basic songs including melody and chords.
- Read and write basic music notation, scales and key signatures.
- Use music notation software and electronic keyboards to compose music.



Advanced Music Theory (Musicianship III)

- Write a variety of musical compositions and perform them using Electronic MIDI keyboards
- Use of music notation and sequencing software, electronic keyboards, and MIDI technology




Band Mr. Hart

- Performs each year at Graduation, as well as the annual Kindergarten Concert, and other performances.








Choir Ms. Hendler
