Things to Know:

- * Wear a properly fitting mask on the bus, in the building, in the hall, in the cafeteria. You only take it off JUST BEFORE you pick up your fork, to eat.

Snack/Mask Break Schedule – grades 6 & 7

Mask breaks are taken outside. Students leave the masks on until the teacher gives the ok. A snack will be distributed. When masks are off, kids do their best to keep a 6-foot distance between themselves and others. Blue and Yellow boxes indicate when “In Person” students attend that class. They also guide Distance Learning (DL) students to know when they should attend Live Zooms per the instructions on their teachers’ Canvas pages. Students who are in Distance Learning at Rogers are expected to keep pace with their In Person peers. It is critical that DL students make every effort to join the Live Zooms on the schedule outlined on their teachers’ Canvas home pages. The level of engagement for DL students will look different based upon the level of engagement, grade level of student, etc. DL student should not expect that same level of engagement with their teachers as In Person students will receive. DL student should also communicate with their teachers if they are going to miss a Live Zoom for a Doctor’s appointment, illness, etc.
