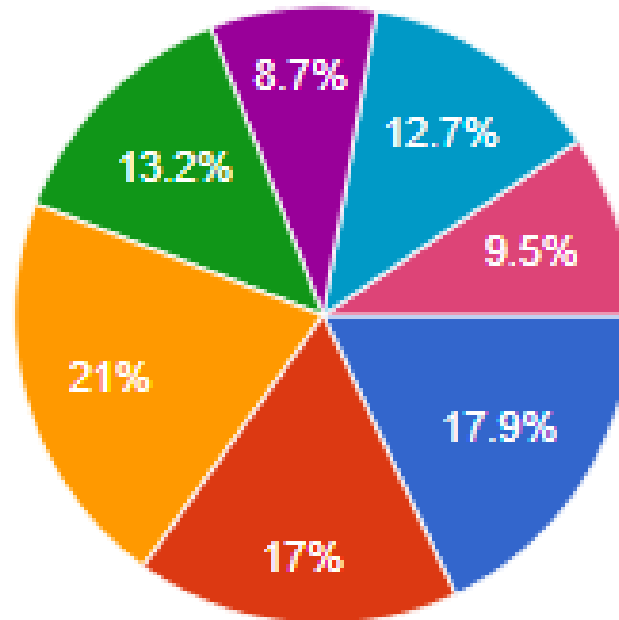

7<sup>th</sup> grade: 107 respondents  
8<sup>th</sup> grade: 132 respondents  
9<sup>th</sup> grade: 83 respondents  
10<sup>th</sup> grade: 55 respondents  
11<sup>th</sup> grade: 80 respondents  
12<sup>th</sup> grade: 60 respondents



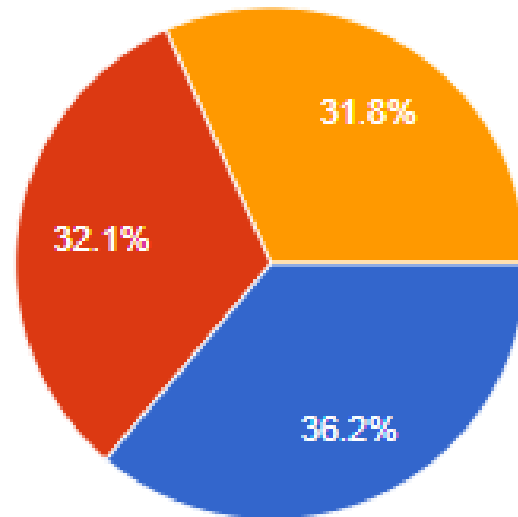

630 Respondents

51% of students enrolled in CMS and CHS participated in the survey

Virtual: 229 people selected this option  
Hybrid: 203 people selected this option  
In-Person: 201 people selected this option

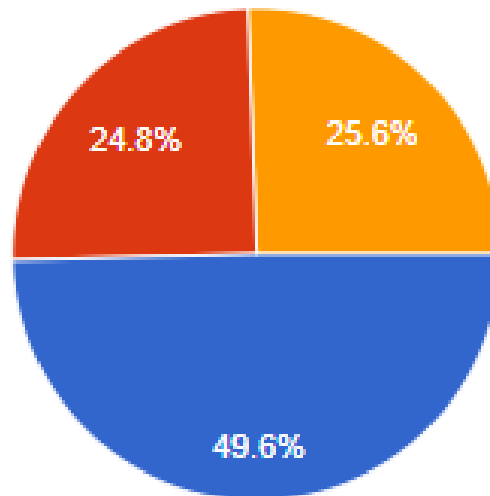

## 3. Which learning mode do you prefer?

120 Respondents



- Virtual
- Hybrid - A/B Model

Virtual: 64 people selected this option  
Hybrid: 32 people selected this option  
In-Person: 33 people selected this option

76% of CMS and CHS staff participated in the survey

Important to note – respondents could choose more than one option.

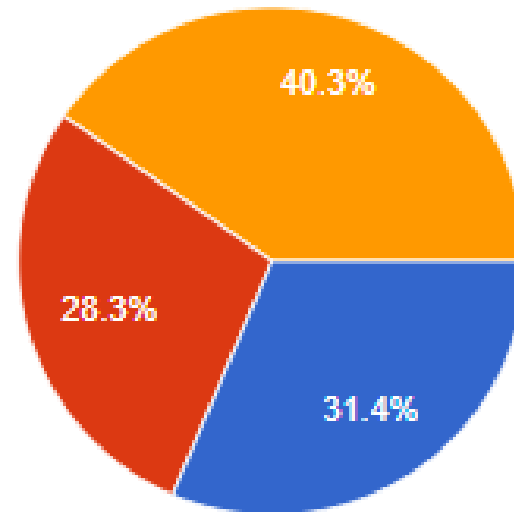
# 6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Parents/Guardians Survey Results



## 3. Which learning mode do you prefer?

369 Respondents

30% of parents/guardians of students enrolled in CMS and CHS participated in the survey

Virtual: 120 people selected this option  
Hybrid: 108 people selected this option  
In-Person: 154 people selected this option

Important to note – respondents could choose more than one option.

# Stakeholder Survey Response Overview



- Students at the secondary level prefer **virtual** at **36.2%** (total respondents)
- Staff at the secondary level prefer **virtual** at **49.6%** (total respondents)
- Parents at the secondary level prefer full **in-person** at **40.3%** (total respondents)
