Return to Learn Updates

• **Schedule Updates:** Please be sure to know the following upcoming schedule changes due to staff receiving the COVID-19 Vaccine next week:

Tuesday, February 23: Elementary will have an Asynchronous Remote Learning Day, with no in-person classes and no "live" remote instruction. Teachers will provide pre-recorded lessons and/or assignments for students to work on at home. Middle School will continue with their Hybrid/In-Person Plan following AM/PM Schedule.

Monday, March 1: Elementary and Middle School will have a Full Remote Learning Day, with no inperson classes. All students will have "live" remote instruction following the AM/PM Schedule.

- Spring Wood Hybrid Learning Plan: As we begin the third trimester next Monday, February 22, we are very excited to transition our middle school students to the Hybrid Model with some students returning to inperson learning and some students continuing with remote-only learning. Spring Wood Families should have received student class schedules, bus schedules, and additional information from the school.
