- Students missing two assignment deadlines will be exited from the Platinum Program. There are no exceptions.

Enrichment Project Requirements:

Students will be required to plan, submit, and complete an enrichment project that demonstrates personal or intellectual growth.

- Proposal-** Brief synopsis of the enrichment project *(Due: Spring of Sophomore year)*
- Research Opportunities-** Documented consultation with the West High librarians or another expert in the field related to your project *(Due: Beginning of Junior year)*
- Abstract-** Detailed submission on your enrichment project, what you will do, how you will go about it, why you chose this specific project *(Due: Fall of Junior year)*
- Internal Review-** Presentation of project before an Adjudication Panel to determine viability *(Due: Fall of Senior year)*
- Platinum Bear Symposium-** Participation in school and community "Ted Talk" format delivery of your project. *(Due: Spring of Senior year)*

Distinctions:

Students who finish all requirements of the Platinum Program will be honored at West High's graduation and recognized through various community outlets.
