## CFES PTO MINUTES – NOVEMBER 4, 2020

- Meeting Started at: 9:30 a.m. virtually on Zoom
- Meeting Minutes: Christina Condelles presented the October meeting minutes. They
  were reviewed and approved.
- **Review and Approve Budget:** Hoang Nguyen presented the *October 2020* budget and operating expenses so far.

**Expenditures included**: \$253.11 for teacher grants and \$300.00 for Buddy Breakfast. **Income included**: \$434.00 from spirit wear, \$21.00 from passive fundraising, \$40 from 4<sup>th</sup> grade skating party donations, and \$868.63 from yearbook sales. The budget was approved.

- **PTO Report:** Meredith Petruccelli shared these updates:
  - (1) Every school logo mask was sold. We had \$430 in kids mask sales and \$76 in teacher mask sales.
  - (2) The district will begin using the Peach Jar program to send out flyers.
  - (3) CFES has new Facebook and Instagram pages. Amy Day is looking for small nuggets of info to post online and in the PTO newsletters.
  - (4) The district community scholarship fund is asking for donations for 2021 graduates, along with donations for the holidays for KACS. The PTO will contribute \$450 for both.
- Foreign Language Club: Elisa Maas says the Spanish club is starting on November 11<sup>th</sup>. There are 10 students signed up for 16 virtual sessions through March 17<sup>th</sup>. There was insufficient interest to run the French club this year.
- Passive Fundraising: Jessica Lang shared updates on this year's fundraisers.
  - (1) Mod Pizza was on October 22<sup>nd</sup>. We're still waiting on results. CFE will get 20% of sales.
  - (2) Clean Juice is on November 23<sup>rd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, and 25<sup>th</sup>. They will make a 25% donation to CFE.
  - (3) We had a lower participation rate this year for Square One Art. Our profit was \$200. We will look into doing it again in the Spring.
- **Principal's Report:** Danielle Clark presented several updates:
  - (1) Thank you to the PTO for organizing Buddy Breakfast. The kids were so excited to take part.
  - (2) Students have been very enthusiastic to show school spirit with the new CFE masks.

- (3) She will put family Halloween pictures sent in to the yogile link on a slide show presentation.
- (4) Virtual conference signups have been sent out. Parents can contact teachers to set up a different time.
- (5) November's core essential trait is gratitude. She is encouraging students to send happy notes to teachers and there are coloring pages for the kids.
- (6) The next Chat with Clark Zoom call in December will focus on finding ways to connect remote and in-person students.
- (7) CFES has scheduled school picture day for December.
- (8) Looking to purchase a replacement mascot costume for Chadd the Charger and donate the old one to Mitchell Elementary.
- **3**<sup>rd</sup> **Grade Read-A-Thon:** Katherine Lombardo presented an update on plans for the event. It's been difficult to translate this in-person event into a virtual format. She will track minutes read on google. She is looking into getting pencil cases, books and activity packets for the kids and organizing a group Kahoot online.
- Box Tops: Jeff Ellison shared that we made \$115 in donations. This Fall was the last of the cutouts format for box tops. We will try and get more people enrolled in the virtual box tops program.
- **Art Show:** Jeff Ellison says our chairperson can't do it this year. We will need more volunteers to make a virtual sale possible.
- **Review of Enrichment Grant Requests:** There is a total of \$5,000 in the budget for grants this year. \$2,500 has been set aside for Fall and \$2,500 for the Spring. Meredith Petruccelli presented the list of teacher and staff requests:
