## COVID-19 Cases

As of February 16, 2021 the official adjusted case rate for LA County is 20.0 per 100,000. Given the distribution of the vaccine, it is likely that these numbers will continue to decrease and hopefully we will be in the red tier very soon. LA County would need to have an adjusted case rate of 7 per 100,00 to be in the red tier.

## Senate Bill 86 and Assembly Bill 86

California lawmakers are currently working on legislation through SB86 and AB86 for California schools to offer some sort of in-person instruction to students by April 15, if their County is in the red tier. We will continue to keep you updated as this legislation will be voted on early next week by California lawmakers.

## Next Steps for Fenton

While elementary schools in LA County met the threshold to reopen, our current numbers are still higher than they have been for most of the pandemic in LA County. Fenton schools serve communities that have been hit hardest by the pandemic. For example, Pacoima has the highest number of COVID-19 cases in LA County. Lake View Terrace and Sun Valley also have some of the highest COVID-19 cases in the county. Fenton is in the process of gathering input from our staff and families to ensure we meet the needs of our communities. We want to make sure we identify families that are interested in some form of in-person instruction as health conditions continue to improve.
