

Linking articles from EBSCO, Gale, ProQuest, and Credo into Blackboard

To link articles from EBSCO into Blackboard

Find the article that you want to share. Select “Permalink” from the right-hand side of the screen. Copy this link. In Blackboard, select Build Content, then choose “Web Link.” Name the link and paste the “Permalink” into the URL field. Click “Submit.”


To link articles from Gale into Blackboard

Find the article that you want to share. Select “Bookmark” from the top right-hand side of the screen. This will generate a link that you can copy and paste. Copy this link. In Blackboard, select Build Content, then choose “Web Link.” Name the link and paste it into the URL field. Click “Submit.”

To link articles from ProQuest into Blackboard

Find the article that you want to share. Select “Details” from the top left-hand side of the screen. Scroll down to find the “Document URL.” Copy this link. In Blackboard, select Build Content, then choose “Web Link.” Name the link and paste it into the URL field. Click “Submit.”

To link articles from Credo Reference into Blackboard

Find the article that you want to share. Select the Permalink icon  from the top right-hand side of the screen. Copy this link. In Blackboard, select Build Content, then choose “Web Link.” Name the link and paste it into the URL field. Click “Submit.”
