<p>World History - Level 1 <i>Students currently enrolled in U.S. History 2 - Level 1 who achieve a grade of B- or higher may continue in the Accelerated sequence.</i></p> <p>Students earning a final grade of A- or higher in U.S. 2 - Level 2 may seek placement to World History - Level 1 by attaining the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Teacher recommendation based on demonstrated achievement/ability as evidenced by classroom performance and/or assessments - Final Grade of A- in English 2 - Level 2 	<p>European History - Advanced Placement (AP) <i>Students currently enrolled in World History - AP who achieve a grade of B- or higher may continue in the Honors sequence.</i></p> <p>Students earning a final grade of A or higher in World History - Level 1 may seek placement in European History - AP by attaining the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Teacher recommendation based on demonstrated achievement/ability as evidenced by classroom performance and/or assessments - Final grade of B- or higher in English Language & Composition - AP OR A- or better in English 3 - Level 1
