Any parent/guardian interested in their child being tested for the program will need to sign and return the permission slip below to their child's school.

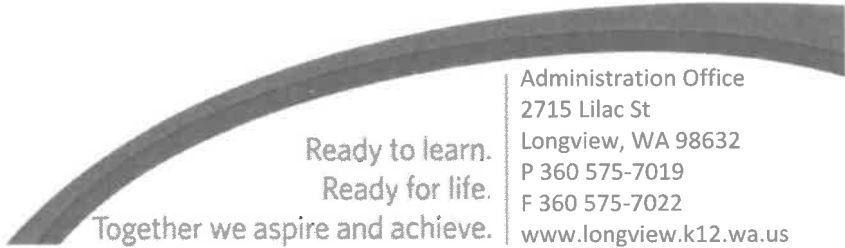
