

Annual Building Report:

North Bellingham

Campus Details:

The North Bellingham campus hosts a variety of Ferndale School District programs. During the 2017/2018 School Year, the building was home to Windward High School (which will be closed at the end of the 2018 school year), Early Kindergarten, Ferndale Family Connections and Head Start programs. The school was originally built in 1938 as an Elementary school. There have been five upgrades since it was built.

2017-2018 Ferndale School District Maintenance Projects at North Bellingham:

- Landscape improvements
- Installed netting in playground area to deter birds
- HVAC maintenance and daily checks during winter season
- Adding changing tables in existing bathrooms (Summer 2018)

2017-2018 Building Usage:

The following Ferndale School District programs were housed at the North Bellingham building over the 2017-2018 school year:

- **Windward High School:** Offered through the 2017-2018 school year, Windward was a choice school for high school students.
- **Ferndale Family Connections:** The Ferndale Family Connections program is a blend of home-based instruction and cooperative learning supported by the Ferndale School District.
- **Ferndale Community Transitions:** A program designed to help qualified 18-21 year old students with disabilities transition from school to work.
- **Play & Learn:** A program targeted towards families with kids aged birth - 5-years-old.
- **(New) Spring & Summer Jump Start:** Spring Jump Start is a new program that adds to our existing Summer program. The program is designed to add an additional opportunity to prepare qualified students for Kindergarten.
- **Head Start Preschool:** A federally funded program designed to increase school readiness for qualified kids and families.
