STANDARDIZED PROVINCIAL TESTING

West Island College awards grades according to Alberta Education guidelines. Alberta students must write standardized Grade 12 Diploma Exams in all core courses. These exams are administered by Alberta Education and are worth 30% of students' final grades in these courses.
