

CLEARFIELD CITY
\$1000 SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

1. Student must be a resident of Clearfield City and attending Clearfield High School with a graduation date of May or June 2021.
2. Student must have a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.5 or higher.
3. Student must have previously completed a service project for the City. Special preference should be given to any student who successfully served as a member of the Clearfield City Youth Council. Please document what the service project was and where and when it took place or document the student's participation in the Youth City Council. Completed service projects might include Boy and Girl Scout projects that benefited the community of Clearfield, church service projects that benefited the community of Clearfield, school service projects that benefited the community of Clearfield or Clearfield Youth City Council projects.

Note: The scholarship is deferrable for up to five years when the recipient commits to a service opportunity with a charitable institution or governmental entity which may include but not be limited to religious, military, Peace Corps, etc. A recipient may apply for a deferment in writing which must include a copy of the commitment contract or letter from such institution. If the deferment has not been claimed by the recipient at the conclusion of five years from the date of award it will be forfeited by the recipient.
