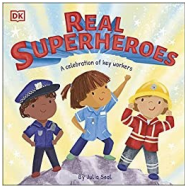


# Reception Term 4 - Overview



## Writing

This term the children will be developing their writing skills in writing facts they have learnt about 'Real Life Superheroes'. Children will write sentences in meaningful contexts and apply their phonic knowledge to write in ways which match their spoken sounds. Children will also develop their common word knowledge and spelling. Each week, children will learn about a different profession and create posters about what they do and how they do it.

## Reading

Over the term, the children will be learning about a range of different professions. Children will be exposed to a range of Non-Fiction books based around these professions and children will be taught how to gather information from these books. Children will continue to use their phonic knowledge to decode and read words and show a good understanding of what they have read.



## Understanding of the World — Technology

Throughout the term, children will develop their understanding how technology is used in different places and for different purposes. They will explore the different technology is used. Children will also begin to think about the range of places that technology can be used, for example in Ambulances.



## Understanding of the World

The children will be looking at different occupations and ways of life throughout the term. Children will show an interest in different occupations through role play opportunities and meeting people from different professions. Children will begin to show a good understanding of what they do and how they work.



## Physical Development

The children will be developing their skills in the 'Physical Cog'. Children will be able to perform a small range of skills and link two movements together. They will also be able to perform skills or movements with some control. Through health and safety, children will be developing their understanding of transporting and storing equipment safely.

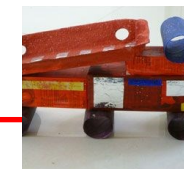
## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children will become more confident in initiating conversations and asking questions of others. They will develop their skills when speaking to others about their own wants, needs, interests and opinions and show understanding that not everyone enjoys the same things. Through the topic children will learn about adapting their behaviour to different events and situations.



## Expressive Arts and Design

Children will be exploring different media that can be used to create different effects based around our topic. Children will explore media and materials to find different ways to create representations of vehicles and devices that may be used by Real Life Superheroes. Children will be able to follow their own interests and explore media based around their own design.



## Maths

Children will continue to develop their number knowledge up to 20. They will be confident in recognising and using these numbers. Children will also start to develop their understanding of doubling, halving and sharing.

Children will know with doubling, the numbers must be the same. When halving it means splitting a number in two and it has to be fair / equal. Children will also know that some numbers cannot be shared as all parts need to be equal.
