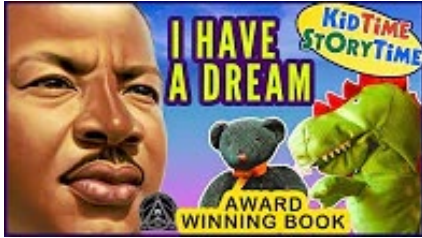

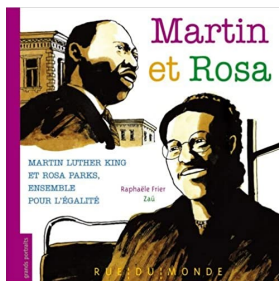

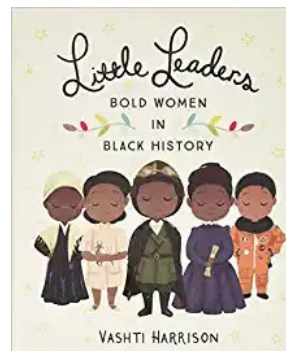
["I Have a Dream" illustrated by Kadir Nelson](#)
