



Summer Camp Policies and Information

1. Arrival and Dismissal

- Carpool arrival runs from 8:30-9:00 a.m.
- Carpool dismissal runs from 3:00-3:15 p.m.

2. After Care

- Families must register and prepay for After Care.
- We will not offer drop-ins for after care.
- We will not offer before care.

3. Camp T-shirts

- Day Campers must wear the camp t-shirt and should wear tennis shoes to camp every day.
- Summer Hearts campers have the option to wear the camp t-shirt.
- Middle School campers do not need to wear the camp t-shirt.

4. Lunch and Snacks

- Campers in Summer Hearts-One-Year-Old and Two-Year-Old programs must bring his/her own lunch each day; however, snacks will be provided.
- Lunch and snacks are included in the Summer Hearts Three-Year-Old program.
- In other camp programs, lunch is included. Campers may bring a morning and afternoon snack.

5. Cancelled Programs

- Sacred Heart reserves the right to change the specifics of a class or activity or to cancel a class or an event. Registration fees will be refunded for any canceled programs.

6. Summer Camp Handbook

- Rules and procedures for summer camp are listed in the SUMMER CAMP HANDBOOK. The camp handbook will be provided to you.

7. Payment

- All balances are due in full by May 14, 2021, to reserve the camper's spot.
- There are no refunds issued after May 10, 2021.

- Any outstanding balance remaining on the account at the end of camp will be charged to the credit card on file.

8. Late Arrival or Absence

9. Weather Closure

- The safety and well-being of our Camp community is our first priority and commitment. Sacred Heart carefully monitors weather forecasts in order to make well-informed decisions on whether to close Camp for a day or dismiss early, in the event of inclement weather. Sacred Heart administrators understand parents' need to make plans in advance.
- Our decisions are made in consideration of the latest weather forecasts and any applicable city-wide announcements.
- Any decision to change the regularly scheduled Camp program will be communicated as quickly as possible via our Bright Arrow emergency notification system. Parents of Camp participants will be automatically enrolled in this system at the onset of their child's Camp session.
- There will be no refunds issued due to camp closing for issues out of our control.

10. Registration

- Registration will close at 10:00 a.m. on Friday before a new session begins.
