For a graduating student from North County of Santa Barbara with a 3.0 GPA enrolling in a four-year accredited college enrolling in natural sciences. In addition to the autobiographical essay, the applicant must submit an essay of 500 or fewer words related to goals within a natural science field (student to specify). Priority will be given to a student with a financial need to pursue higher education. Support awarded for each of up to four years based on acceptable performance and continuation towards bachelor's degree.

Scholarship Amount: \$5,000

[\$2,000 awarded year one; \$1,000 awarded year two, three, and four based on acceptable performance. Award paid directly to the student's school tuition account.]
