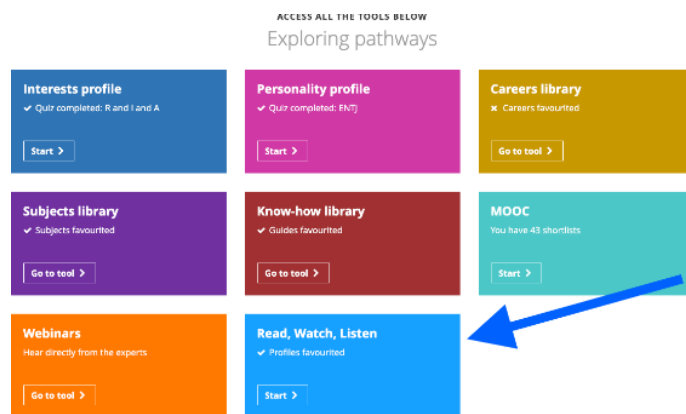
Yr 10 – Y13 Exciting New Resources – Read, Watch, Listen
