We are delighted to welcome all of your children back into school next Monday 8th March. Please look out for the email I will be sending on Wednesday giving all the procedures and details of how the school will work from 8th March. I would be grateful if you could read this carefully.

We realise that lockdown will have impacted on our families and our children negatively, especially emotionally. When the children come back to school, our teachers will be working hard to ensure that all families are supported. If there is any event or circumstances that you feel we should know about to support your child in school, then please would you let us know in confidence.

Last week, our school had a thorough safeguarding inspection by our MAT (Stowe Valley Multi-Academy Trust). I am delighted to tell you that we got a GREEN-rating, which is the highest level. This is because our fabulous staff, children and parents work together to follow rules and speak out if something does not 'feel right'. It is no accident that Safeguarding is a strength at our school.

The government has cancelled all statutory tests this summer, so this means that Year 6 SATs and Year 2 SATs tests will not take place. Our Year 6 teachers will be providing feedback information to the relevant secondary schools.

Many children have entered a Bake-Off competition and the winners and their spectacular bakes can be seen inside this newsletter. Also, there is news from FoBIPS who continue to invent and put on wonderful events to support our community socially, and to support our school financially.

Children do not know if they can't see properly.

With the lockdown caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, many children will have missed their annual appointments to have their eyes tested.

Eye appointments at opticians are free of charge for children and so are glasses.

Every year we have about three children in our school who need glasses to see and learn properly and their parents did not realise. Please make an appointment for an eye check for your child so the experts can confirm that your child can see properly. If you wish to discuss this or need support, please contact us.

Registering for Free-School Meals

For families who are on lower income, the Government gives their children's school extra money and it also gives the children free school meals. This is called Pupil Premium Status. This money makes a real difference to our school. It helps us pay for a Teaching Assistant in every class every morning of the week. It also helps us to run catch-up learning groups for children who need it.

Children in Reception, Year One and Year Two receive free school meals but this alone does not trigger the Government to give us Pupil Premium money. For this to be paid, parents must register on-line using the link below. It is quick, confidential and benefits your child and other children in the school enormously.

Those children registered for Free School Meals (Pupil Premium) school can contribute towards school for trips, uniform and after-school activities and food vouchers when school has been in lock-down.
