Sophomore Frequently Asked Questions

Driver's Education:

Q: Is there Summer Driver's Ed?

A: No. Unfortunately there is no in-person Driver's Ed this year.

Q: Are there other options for Driver's Ed?

A: Yes, students can complete the curriculum online through Davis Connect and complete the driving hours at FHS once your online course is completed. Your Jr. High Counselor will sign you up for Summer online.

Q: How/where does Driver's Ed go in my schedule?

A: The system will automatically place you in the correct term, based on your birthday. Driver's Ed is paired with Study Skills. THIS IS NORMAL! You have to take both because they are .25 each

Fit for Life:

Q: Do I have to take Fit for Life?

A: Yes, Fit for Life is a State requirement for graduation, in addition to 1.0 credits of general PE

Q: Does "Get Fit" count as Fit for Life?

A: No, it does not. It will count as a general PE credit.

Q: Can playing a sport @ FHS, Cheer, Drill or Marching Band count for Fit for Life?

A: Yes. If your student is planning to be in a Team Conditioning class for a UHSAA sanctioned sport, in the marching band, on the Drill or Cheer team, they will have the option to complete the Fit for Life coursework through Canvas and receive .50 Fit for Life credit. Non-sanctioned sports will not have this option.

Q: Are there other options for Fit for Life?

A: Yes. A student can opt to take Fit for Life online through Davis Connect. If you are wanting to do it over summer before 10th grade, your Jr. High Counselor will sign you up.

Digital Studies

Q: What courses are offered at FHS to fulfill the Digital Studies credit?

A: See FHS Course Catalog for course descriptions and best choice for you.

Classes offered at FHS to fulfill Digital Studies requirement:

1. AP Computer Science Principles
2. Business Office Specialist (CE)
3. Computer Programming
4. Digital Business Applications
5. Exploring Computer Science

Q: Do I have to fulfill this graduation requirement in 10th grade?

A: No. You may wait until 11th grade to take an option which fulfills the Digital Studies requirement and offers Concurrent Enrollment.

Concurrent Enrollment (CE)

Q: What CE classes can I get CE credit for as a Sophomore?

A: Sophomores can take any CE class but are not eligible to earn CE credit in certain courses. In some cases it may be best to wait until Jr. year. See FHS website "Concurrent Enrollment"

Science & Honors Science

Q: What Science classes are required for graduation?

A: To meet state requirements for science, students need two (2) of the following: Earth Systems, Biology, AP Biology, Chemistry, AP Chemistry, Physics, AP Physics1, or AP Physics C.

3rd year sciences include any of the core sciences listed above, plus:

Marine Biology, Ornithology, Astronomy 1 and 2, Botany, Bio-tech and Medical Anatomy/Physiology.

Q: Can I get Honors Science credit?

A: Students who are interested in the honors distinction can complete additional work in the traditional Biology, Chemistry and Physics courses. This additional work will reflect on the student's transcript as an Honors course after extra work is completed.

World Languages

Q: What Language courses are offered at FHS?

A: American Sign Language, Chinese, French, German & Spanish are all available for Sophomores to take.
