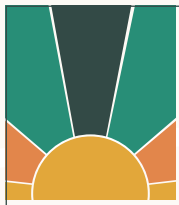

INSECT INVESTIGATIONS

Did you know that dragonflies have ancestors that existed 325 million years ago and some had wingspans over 2 feet wide? Or did you know that 25% of all animal species on earth are some type of beetle? Come learn more through activities and exploration in our Insect Investigations camp! We'll search on land and in water for insects, spiders, and other related creepy crawlies. Discover the wild ways insects hunt and eat, make their homes, and other fascinating aspects of their lives.

WILDERNESS LIVING SKILLS
