

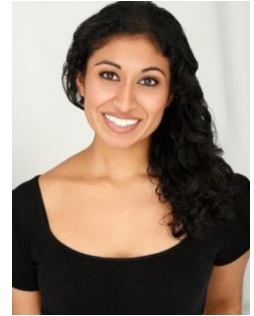

Nivedita Kulkarni is a writer, actress, and comedian based in NYC.

She recently acted in the series “Night Crew,” which won the New York Film & TV Festival and was purchased by Comedy Central. Most recently, Nivedita won the ABC SAMMA Diversity Initiative (2020), where she worked with ABC Network casting directors on preparing for leading primetime roles. Previously, Nivedita was chosen as one of 16 honorees for HBO’s East of Main Street, profiling Hollywood’s most promising Asian American talent. Having previously worked as a print model, Nivedita is a former national face of Bank of America.

Nivedita has written, produced, and acted in shows at: The Upright Citizens Brigade, Caroline’s on Broadway, The PIT, The Magnet, The Dramatists’ Guild, The Producer’s Club, and many other venues throughout New York City. Nivedita is a proud member of sketch comedy teams Horse Club, The Diva, Yuck, Yuck, Goose, and Bold Lip at The People’s Improv Theater in NYC, where she writes and produces sketch comedy. Her independent improv team, Slambot, has performed throughout the city at various theatres and comedy clubs. She performs regularly at open mics at The People’s Improv Theater, Parkside Lounge, The Creek & The Cave, Pioneers Bar, The Producers’ Club, and New York Comedy Club. Recent UCB Theatre credits include Backyard Brawl and Crazy Funny South Asians (playing Kamala Harris). Nivedita co-created the show “Sex Lives of Disney Princesses” at The Upright Citizens Brigade in New York. Her self-produced stage production, How I Died, was reviewed on the front page of The Huffington Post [here](#).

Nivedita currently works as a script reader for the 51 Fund, a private equity fund that invests in films written by women. Since 2017, she has served as a nominator for the Kilroy Awards, which nominates the best unproduced stage plays in the industry written by women. She has also worked as a script reader and assistant at Segal NYC, the production company that co-produced Les Liaisons Dangereuses on Broadway. Nivedita has also formerly worked as the assistant to the Chief Financial Officer of Viacom International Media Networks.

Nivedita founded and runs the company Nuva.io, a group dedicated to empowering women in the entertainment industry through information sharing platforms. She currently serves as the chair of the Washington University Entertainment & Media alumni network, which connects Washington University alumni in entertainment around the country. Nuva.io was recently accepted to the InSITE Program, a pre-accelerator at Wharton Business School.

Nivedita is a graduate of the Olin School of Business at Washington University in St. Louis, where she studied Marketing & Applied Macroeconomics. Nivedita is a former competitive athlete, and she is originally from Chicago.
