Discussion/Action Item

- Discussion and Possible Action of using snow days as remote learning days for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year.

MOTION #21-37: Board member Finnigan moved to approve the use of snow days as remote learning days for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year. Board member Fry seconded the motion. Discussions covered the demonstrated importance of in-person learning, the impact of classes going deeper into June, the idea that learning does not have to stop after Memorial Day, the need for staff to be able to plan for remote learning, the importance of a social/emotional focus, and the possible advantages to having a firm end date for planning purposes. Drzyzga, Gazdik, Finnigan, Fry and Sattan voted in favor. Dudack, Lingenfelter, Mercik Davis and Sepko voted against. The motion carried **5-4**.
