Who Can Attend?

DuPage County residents. Childhood immunizations are available for children who:

- have no insurance
- have insurance that does not cover immunizations
- are medicaid recipients

What to Bring:

- Bring all records of previous immunizations given by a doctor or clinic.
- Records should include any tetanus immunizations received in a hospital emergency room.
- Know the weight of the person being immunized.
