The Salisbury community requires hand sanitizing before entering buildings, classrooms, and dormitories.



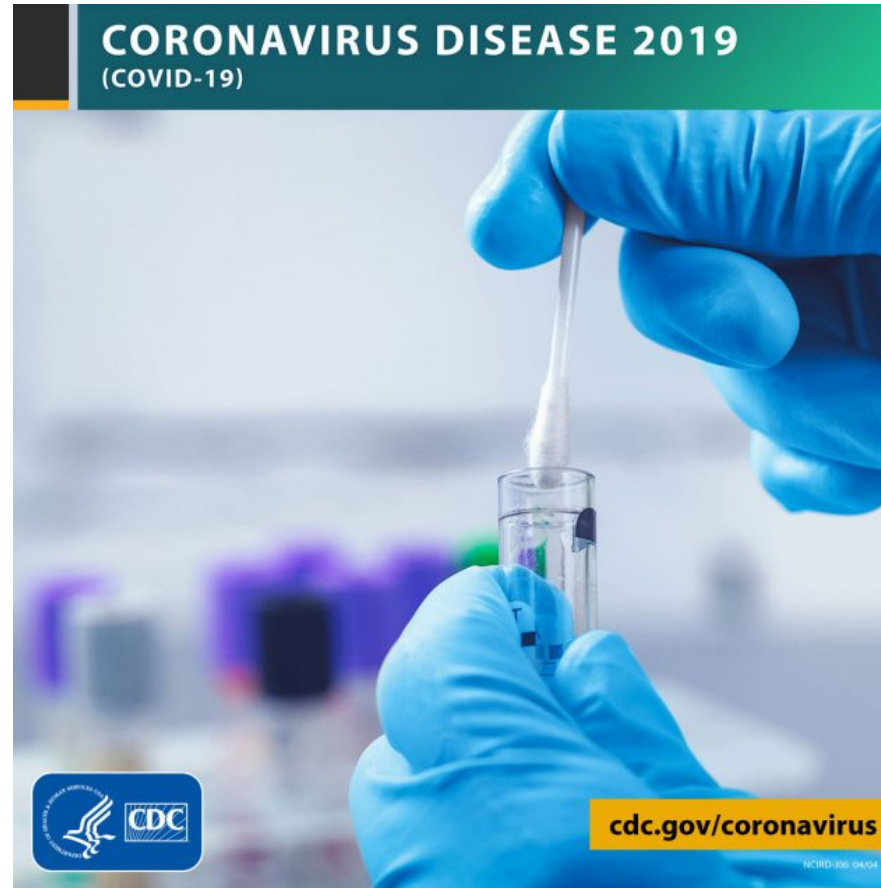
# Increased Sanitization

Salisbury offers a blended classroom to maintain social distancing and our enhanced distance learning to students unable to join campus.



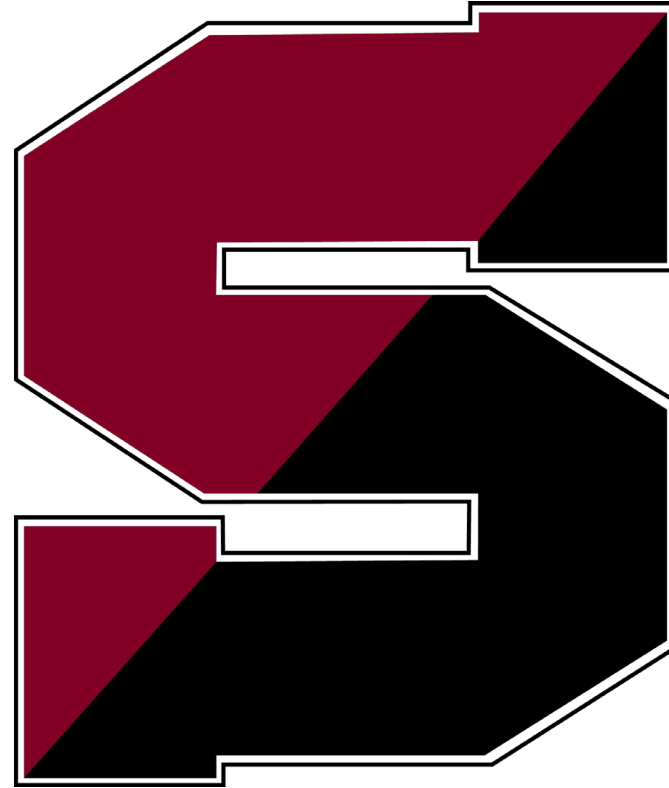
# Academic Environment
