

Inclement Weather Policy

Parents: Please note of special importance.

There may be times during the winter months when AMSA may cancel or delay school based upon road conditions in Marlborough. This may or may not be the case in other towns and cities where our families reside.

There are also times when other towns or cities cancel or delay their school openings because of road conditions in their areas. AMSA may very well be open on time. In this case please see the policy on pick up directly from the AA Bus Company:

CANCELATION AND DELAY POLICY

If the town that School is in :

Cancels The Bus is CANCELLED

Delay The Bus is DELAYED

If the bus picks up in multiple towns:

NO PICK-UP for the towns that are cancelled

If one of the towns a 1 hour delay and another has a 2 hour delay the ROUTE RUNS ON THE GREATER DELAY

- If a student is late getting to school on a school bus and the bus is delayed because of road conditions, the student will not be marked as Tardy.**
- If a parent transports a student to school and a student is Tardy because of road conditions, the student will not be marked Tardy.**
- If a bus is cancelled in any town or city and AMSA is open the student will receive an excused absence but is expected to see teachers for any make-up work.**

AMSA carefully considers the geographical diversity of it's families, the weather conditions in these areas and weighs the safety concerns of opening school on inclement weather days. We take seriously the fact that many parents drive their students to school and make every effort to attend every school day.

Ultimately, it is up to every parent to make the final decision to send their student to school on any given day.
