- Counseling Report: Mr. Brown explained the 7th Grade Open House (Feb 17), Each elementary
 will come at staggered times and a virtual presentation will be available. Registration begins Feb
 10 and is due back Feb 23rd.
 - 8th & 9th grade registration (Feb 22, 23), due back March 4th. 8th Grade is in CCA classes and 9th grade is in History class.
 - 10th Grade Registration for High School, TBA.
- JSSC report: Miss Coyle explained the use of Friday by teachers. It has been beneficial for
 teachers in preparing online work, collaborating, and meeting with students. Miss Coyle
 explained the positives about Fridays including better attendance, better behavior, learning
 simplified and direct, remediation opportunities, connections with students.
 Next year will be a five day-in class schedule as determined by the school board.
 Choices such as online or face to face for students are varied to meet student needs.
- Student report: No Student report
- Mr. Martini reviews school data and discusses 2021 School Improvement goals which includes;
 - 1. Increasing passing rates by 20 students in reading and science.
 - 2. Diverse Learning
 - 3. SEL

Interventions for diverse learners include 1. cotaught core classes, 2. planning together for individual learners especially SPED. 3. learning how to help SPED students 4. helping reach other students who struggle but do no have an IEP, 5. planning with same PREP time within departments, 6. Friday interventions including face to face with students, 7. Friday Planning sessions, 8. 24/7 access to online assignment and guidance, 9. allowing late work (what you know not when) and 10. Teacher PLC days within departments.

Next years suggested goals:

- 1. Increase core passing grades
- 2. Decreasing # of Students credit deficient as they enter High School & overall increase in GPS.
- 3. SEL Atmosphere and attitude about school.

This term 6.8 % failing rate compared to 22% earlier 2nd Term.

- Budget report: Budget is on schedule some things cost less than expected and Community Council will decide how to reassign funds with Teachers Grants or needed equipment.
