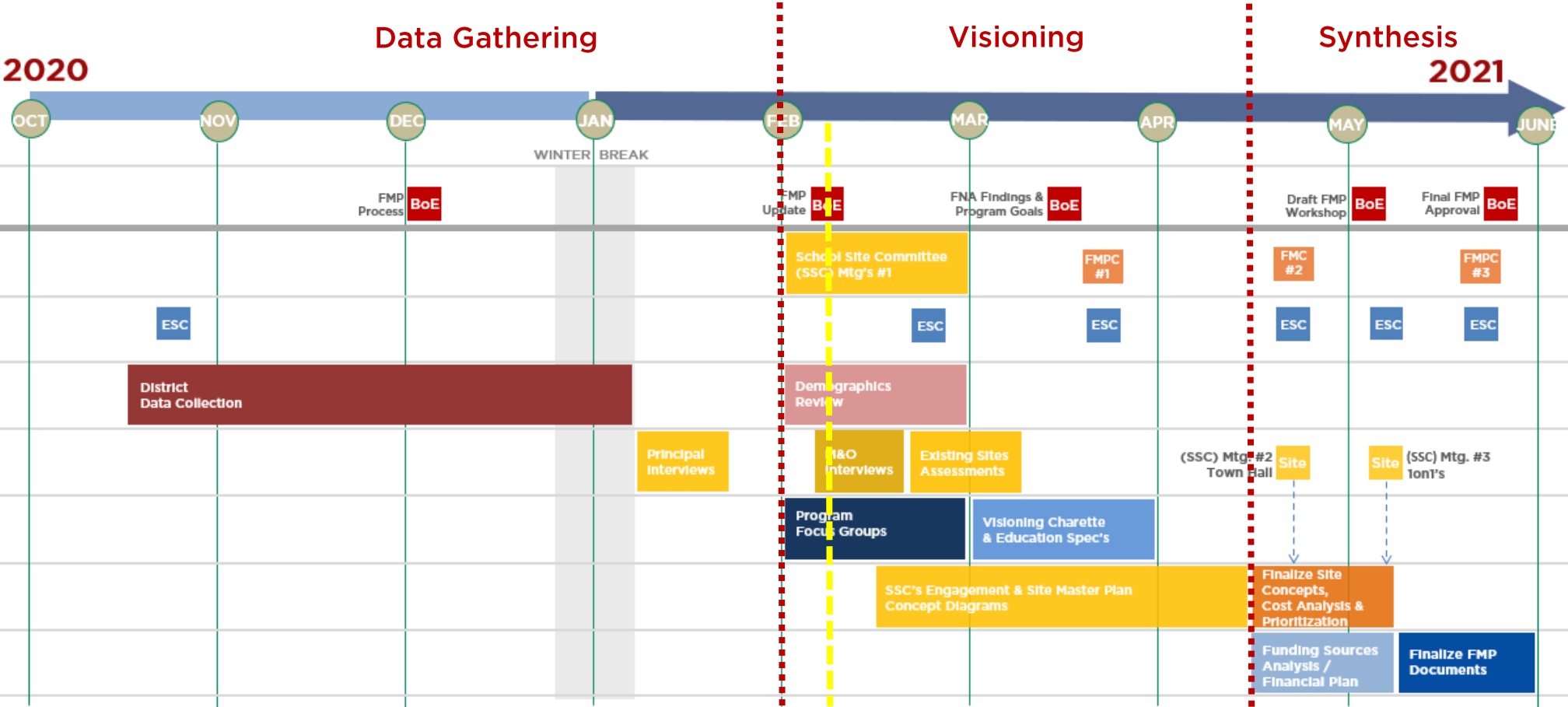
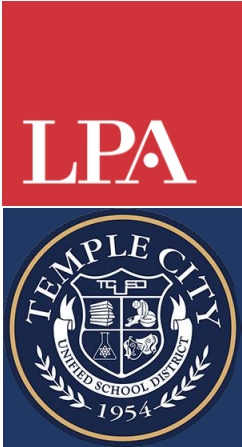

- Create space and provide appropriate learning equipment for the Certified Nursing Assistant Program and Pharmacy Technician Program
- Find or create space for adult programs during the day that do not interfere with the High school site
- Create space for the culinary program

- Update the stadium and track
- Provide areas to display work and storage for classrooms, support spaces, performing arts, and athletics
- Overhaul 601 building's stage area
