When ordering, people will be asked to put the choir student's first and last name - this is very important, so we know who to give credit to, and who should pick up the certificates.

Choir students who have orders placed under their name will receive an email about how to pick up the certificates – we plan to have them ready for pick up on **Saturday**, **December 5**. All orders must be picked up by choir students (or a family member) on that day. Students are then responsible for distributing the certificates to their family and friends accordingly.

All fundraising is optional and accumulated funds in the choir spending account can be used for choir-related expenses such as field trips, uniforms, and extended travel.


