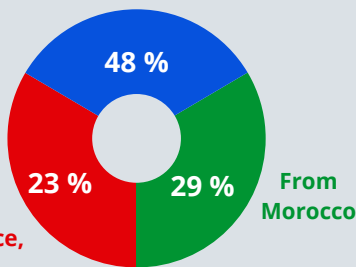

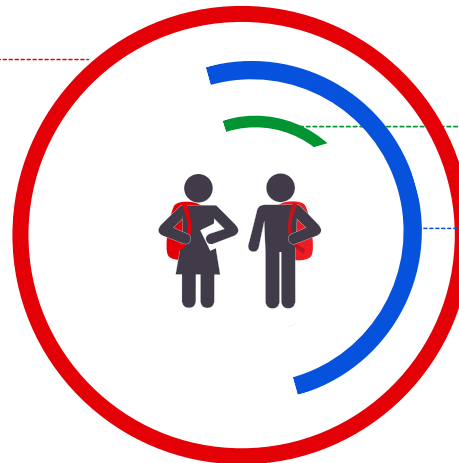

CAS uses the 1-7 numbers as follow:

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS
