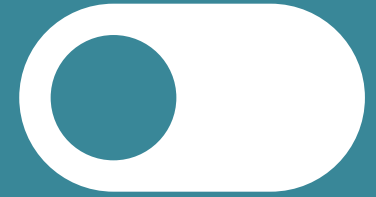


FRANKLIN PIERCE SCHOOLS GRADES 6-8 2021 HYBRID LEARNING PLAN



Franklin Pierce Schools will move toward a Hybrid Learning Model in Spring 2021. Students in grades 6-8 will be able to continue to participate in **full-time remote learning** or participate in **hybrid learning** where they will come to school two days/week for in-person learning. Students that select the hybrid learning option will be divided into two cohorts to increase engagement and allow for students and staff to adhere to health and safety guidelines.

In-person Learning will occur in school buildings two days/week. Students and staff will adhere to a variety of health and safety protocols to reduce the impact of COVID-19.

Teacher directed independent learning will occur on Wednesdays. This will include a variety of learning activities to be completed by students on their own time.

Online Learning with Teacher will occur on days when students are not in the building. Students will login to their assigned classes according to the school bell schedule.

COHORTS

Students will be assigned to a Monday/Thursday or Tuesday Friday cohort for in-person learning to increase engagement and maintain small class sizes to adhere to health and safety guidelines.

ONLINE LEARNING WITH TEACHER

During this time, students will login to CANVAS to participate in class with students that are in the school building. Students will follow their school's bell schedule, with breaks between classes, a lunch break, etc.
