


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#### Lakeview Will Be A Middle College Next Year!

Middle College is a collaboration between a high school and a community college. Students take a combination of core high school courses and college courses to receive their diploma and graduate while providing students the ability to start college early and gain up to 60 college credits.

  GPA at Lakeview.
- Students must be a High School student (Grades 9-12) at Lakeview Leadership Academy.
- Students must turn in periodic Grade Check Verifications from their College Professors so our Counselors can ensure they are excelling and on track.

## Lakeview Middle College Program

#### **Benefits of Middle College**

- Free College Tuition for the courses taken while at Lakeview.
- Smother transition from High School to College.
- Ability to complete college education faster.
- Students can complete a few college courses, or can strive to complete IGETC (Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum). The IGETC is a series of courses that will allow a student to graduate high school and transfer to many UC campuses at a Junior level.

Lakeview Leadership Academy is partnering with Victor Valley Community College (VVC) to offer college courses for our MiddleCollege students. Some courses will be offered on our Lakeview Campus while the majority will be offered on the VVC Campus, which is easier to accomplish due to our close proximity to each other. 
