You will receive a code to register online. This discount applies to new classroom registration only.
- ◆ If a module is missed, the exact same module must be made-up at a future class.
- ◆ **MANDATORY** virtual Parent Class from 6pm-8pm. Parent Class must be taken prior to driving or observing on the road.
- ◆ Personal checks are not accepted. Minimum 1/2 payment due upon registration.
- ◆ Payment Plan options are available in two installments of \$125 each and must be paid in full on or before Mod 7. **All Driver Education vehicles are equipped with surveillance cameras.**
