## Lemon-Lime Mojitarita

Half mojito, half margarita, and wholly delicious, this fun, alcohol-free mocktail can be enjoyed by the entire family!

#### **Ingredients**

- · 1 lime
- · 1 lemon
- · Water (sparkling preferred)
- · 3 tsp of agave nectar or simple syrup (1½ tsp per glass); or artificial sweetener of your choice, to taste.
- · Ice (crushed is best but not necessary)
- · Optional: handful of mint (lavender also works, just use sparingly)
- · Optional: sugar for rimming glass
- · Optional: 1.5oz vodka/white rum/tequila blanco

#### You'll Need

- · Two old fashioned glasses (short tumblers)
- · Peeler
- · Juicer or spoon for juicing the citrus
- · Sharp knife and cutting board

#### Instructions

- 1. Fill each glass with ice.
- 2. Swirl 1½ tsp agave nectar or simple syrup over the ice.
- 3. Peel and reserve 2 wide lemon peels for garnish.
- 4. Cut lemon and lime in half. Juice ½ lemon and ½ lime in each glass.
- 5. Optional: gently bruise mint with your hand, then add preferred amount to each glass.
- 6. Optional: Add alcohol of your choice.
- 7. Top up glass with water.
- 8. Stir to mix.
- 9. Optional: Gently twist the lemon peel garnish over your drink to express its essential oils, then drop it in.
- 10. Enjoy!

Fun margarita-inspired twist: Before adding anything to the glasses: cut the citrus in half, rub the edge of the glass along the fruit, then coat with sugar.

Bidding for both the online and live auction items will be done via our mobile bidding platform, Greater Giving. The auction software allows you set a Max Bid where the system bids in your favor until you are outbid or the auction closes.

#### Collaborative Bidding

Some Auction items may be split amongst friends. Prior to the auction, speak with your friends, collaborate on items that you would like to win together, and select a primary bidder for the group. Please contact development@stthomasschool.org if you have won an item that is intended to be split amongst several purchasers.

#### Certificates

Some packages require the buyer to coordinate with one or several donors. It is important to read all certificates and specifications for each item. If an expiration date is not stated, all items expire one year from the date of the Auction. You must maintain original certificates for redemption purposes. 
