Upper Elementary

Upper Elementary years are a time to master the academic skills students will need in middle school, while retaining the sheer joy of learning of early childhood. Stuart Hall's caring, experienced teachers nurture and inspire students to be joyful, well-rounded, successful students ready to enter Middle School infused with intellectual curiosity, creativity, and the desire to contribute.

Hallmarks of our Upper Elementary experience include:

- Project-based, hands-on learning
- Leadership and Service Learning programs (during and after school)
- Art, Music, Physical Education, and Spanish (90 minutes/week each)
- Technology: basic computer skills, coding, and digital citizenship

... Grades 6-8 The Middle Years

Stuart Hall's Middle Years program for students in grades 6, 7 and 8 provides a vibrant context for academic learning while nurturing the emotional, physical, and social growth that marks these transitional years. The program fosters a sense of belonging and guides students to take increasing responsibility for their learning.

Hallmarks of our Middle Years experience include:

- Challenging curriculum in core subjects
- Interdisciplinary enrichment in Spanish, PE, Art, Music, and Technology
- Off-campus experiences, guest experts, cross-disciplinary projects, and independent research
- Skill building in creative and persuasive writing, public speaking, and problem solving
- Engagement in higher-order thinking through analysis and evaluation of social issues and ethics
- Emphasis on honor and integrity and the Stuart Hall Honor Code
- Small classroom settings and knowledgeable teachers



Transition to Middle Years Grade 6

Stuart Hall 6th graders continue to have one classroom and teacher for the core subjects--a learning environment shown to be the most beneficial for this age group.

Art, Music, PE and Spanish, each offered 2-3 times a week, challenge our students to stretch their muscles (creative and physical) while providing low-stress practice at transitioning to other teachers and classrooms during the school day.

Afterschool, students are invited to participate in a variety of clubs, intramurals and activities which may be led by teachers, parents, or Upper School students.

...Supported Independence Grade 7

Students start to move from classroom to classroom, experiencing multiple teachers for core subjects. A new addition in 7th grade, Advisory gives students a safe foundation from which to explore this new independence, and gives both students and parents a point-of-contact. Advisors know students as multi-dimensional individuals, guiding and supporting them with understanding and love.

Spanish, Art, P.E. and Music continue to provide opportunities for physical and mental growth and artistic expression.

With Upper School approaching, our Learning Specialist helps students begin to integrate college-prep learning skills into their daily classes and course work.

After school, students are invited to participate in a variety of clubs, intramurals and activities which may be led by teachers, parents, or Upper School students.



Preparation for Apper School Grade 8

Students continue building on the firm foundations established in 7th grade, honing the study skills they will need for success in the 9-12th grades. Art, Music and Spanish, each offered 2-3 times a week, continue to challenge our students to stretch their intellectual and creative muscles.

Uniquely, 8th graders start participating in several hallmarks of the upper school experience, including the college counselling process (a low-stress self-exploration of interests and strengths,) Study Hall, and participation with upper school students in sports, theatre, art music and outdoor co-curriculars at the close of the academic day.






