Enrichment Classes

Enrichment classes begin the week of April 12th. Classes will run through the week of May 31st. There will be a make up week of June 7th, only if needed by the teachers. Registration and payment must be submitted by March 26th. Payments can be made online through the registration form or mailed to the school with check, % Enrichment Programs.

PJS Instrumental Program

Individual music lessons will be offered on afternoons after school throughout the week at prearranged times. Students may choose piano, guitar, drums, flute, clarinet, saxophone, ukulele and violin. Please see the registration form for details and submit with payment by March 26th.

After School Drop-in
