

**VALEDICTORIAN AND SALUTATORIAN SELECTION
(REGULATION)**

The honor of high school valedictorian will be bestowed on the student(s) who accomplish the following:

- A. Complete course work to satisfy the requirements for a diploma of distinction.
- B. Complete a minimum of three (3) advanced placement (A.P.) classes earning a grade of no less than a “B” each semester.

Of the three (3) A.P. courses completed, the courses must be from at least two (2) different disciplines of study; i.e. science, mathematics, language/art, and social studies.

Examples: two (2) A.P. sciences and one (1) English
 or one (1) history and two (2) English
 or one (1) art, one (1) Spanish, one (1) science
 not two (2) English and one (1) art

- C. Complete all other non AP course work earning no grade less than an “A” each semester.

The honor of high school salutarian will be bestowed on the student(s) who has the second highest grade point average utilizing the same criteria referenced for valedictorian.

To be eligible to be named valedictorian or salutarian, a student must have attended Piedmont School District the full senior year.
