



## Senior Forecasting

- If you have not taken Biology yet, you must take it as a senior. If you have taken Biology, consider whether or not you want to take an advanced science class (check with the department to see which course(s) you are eligible to take).
- Have you taken all your required courses (PE, Health, Speech, Government, Information Science)? If not, you must forecast for the remaining requirements. Check specifically to make sure you have taken at least 1 semester of an Information Science course. If you still need to take either Health 2 or Government, you also have the option of taking one of them over the summer instead.
- Do you want to have a semester of Senior Study Privilege? You **MUST** forecast for it in order to have it in your schedule. You cannot drop a class to add in a Senior Study Privilege. You cannot choose the block of your Senior Study Privilege. You may only have one semester of Senior Study Privilege.
- Do you want to take a 4<sup>th</sup> year of Math or World Language? Neither are required for graduation (as long as you have completed Algebra 2 and 2 consecutive years in the same language), but they may be recommended. This would be important to discuss with your college counselor.
- If you are taking the regular English 12 course, pick your top choice for each semester on your forecasting form and in PowerSchool. However, you may end up in any of the course offerings depending on what fits into your schedule. We cannot make changes to your schedule based on your English course preferences.
