Where we are today

- In early Feb. we announced that distance learning would continue through April 9
 - Since the start of the semester, small groups of students have been brought on to campuses for academic support
- Santa Clara County moved into the Red Tier of the state's reopening system on March 3
- We are seeing some more flexibility in some of the requirements for reopening
- However, Districts are still subject to the six-foot distancing requirement and stable cohorts are recommended, but not required
- The Governor and the legislature released their reopening plan and it was passed last week
 - Funding embedded in the plan is based on students and staff returning for in-person instruction

Where we are today

- FUHSD started Emergency Learning – March 2020
- Santa Clara County moved into the **Purple Tier** – November 17, 2020
- SCVAL Season 1 Practice begins for **Purple Sports** – February 1, 2021
- Vaccination available to educators – February 28, 2021
- SCVAL Season 2 Practice begins for **Purple Sports** – March 1, 2021
- Santa Clara County moved into the **Red Tier** – March 3, 2021
- Limitation of two-cohorts per student changed from **Required** to **Recommended** on March 3, 2021
- Agreement reached with State to resume indoor sports - March 4, 2021

Where we are today

- Vaccinations for teachers and school staff began on Feb. 28
- In a recent survey of our staff:
 - About 440 of 1,000 employees responded
 - Approximately 82% of those that have responded have already had one dose of the vaccine, 4% have had both doses and 9% have a first dose appointment scheduled
 - There are still some challenges with availability, but we will continue to survey and provide information to our staff for to assist those that are struggling to make an appointment
 - The SCCOE and SCCPHD have been incredibly helpful in providing direct assistance to our district in getting staff vaccinated

- Qualtrics screening tool
- Reporting of positive COVID-19 cases and contact tracing in partnership with the County
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- New guidance on cleaning vs. sanitization
- Full HVAC assessment and upgrades of ventilation systems

- CAASPP/Smarter Balance testing for 11th/12th graders is currently on hold due to recent changes at the Federal and State level (was previously scheduled for April 5-9)
- AP Testing
 - The test schedule has been released
 - Currently working on technical accessibility plans
 - Families/students don't need to do anything in their accounts to get assigned correct test dates
- ACT: April 17 at MVHS
- SAT: May 8 at MVHS
 - College Board eliminated subject tests and essay portion of SAT exams
