

OPEN TRANSFER POLICY

The Piedmont Board of Education recognizes that its foremost responsibility is to provide quality educational services for students who live within the legal, geographic attendance boundaries of the District.

Piedmont Public Schools faces ongoing challenges in providing teaching, administrative and support staff as well as adequate classroom teaching and co-curricular activity facilities and related equipment. It is, therefore, the policy of the Piedmont Board of Education not to approve out-of-district transfer requests, except as noted below:

Out of District Employee/Student Transfer: Upon approval by the superintendent or designee, and pursuant to regulations, a student whose residence is not within the boundary of Piedmont Schools shall be allowed to transfer into the Piedmont School district if the parent, or legal guardian of the student is employed in a full-time capacity by the district. 70 O.S. §1-116 This transfer need be approved by the receiving district only. 70 O.S. §8-113

The Board reserves the right, under extenuating circumstances, to approve a transfer on an individual basis.
