Academic Diploma with Honors

24 Carnegie Units (240 QSI Units)

Requirements are the same as The Academic Diploma with the added condition that accumulated credits include at least two AP courses.

General Diploma*

22 Carnegie Units (220 QSI Unit Credits)

English (40), Science (20), Technology (10), Mathematics (20), Fine Arts (10), Personal Health (20), Foreign Language (20), Cultural Studies (30), Electives (50)
