I. PURPOSE

This policy establishes a clear statement of the purpose for which the school district exists.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

The District Purpose Statement shall be:
“High expectations. High achievement for all. No excuses.”

III. REVIEW

The School Board shall from time to time conduct a review of the Purpose Statement as well as the Vision Statement and Core Values described in the District Strategic Plan. Such review may or may not result in a change to the general statement of policy.

IV. RATIONALE

The School Board believes that a purpose statement is important. It should reflect the values of the community, direct change efforts based on the best education information available and should be the basis on which decisions are made.
