## BOYS BASKETBALL GETS WIN AT NOUVEL; HOCKEY DROPS HIGH SCORING GAME TO LAKERS

### IRISH GET ROAD WIN OVER SAGINAW NOUVEL

The Notre Dame Boys Varsity Basketball team earned a tough road win against Nouvel Catholic Central, 76-66. After being down 37-36 at the half, the Irish outscored Nouvel 27-14 in the third quarter and kept the lead for the game. Senior captain Jacob Bendtsen had a season-high 27 points along with eight rebounds. Junior Jack Olis hit four three pointers in the third quarter and six total for the game, to finish with 22 points. Junior Jon Risi added 19 points for the Irish in the win.

### LAKERS BEST IRISH IN HIGH SCORING GAME

The Notre Dame Hockey team dropped a high-scoring 8-6 game to West Bloomfield. The Lakers jumped out to a five goal lead that the Irish could not recover from. Brady Bassett and Evan Gaeschke both scored twice for Notre Dame while David Mohr and Brett Tice also had goals for the Irish in the loss.

### KNIGHTS TAKE ONE GOAL DECISION FROM IRISH

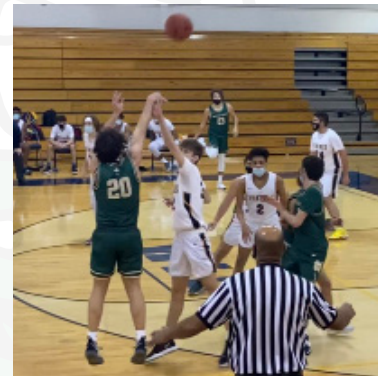
