Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Pre-Kindergarten: Continue in-person every day

Elementary (Grades Y5 - 6): Home-based (full Virtual) for students and parents who selected this option. Homeroom (Hybrid) for students and parents who selected this option will continue on hybrid and phase into all-day, every day according to plan released in February with Creekside moving in March 22nd with Wylie.

Middle School (Grades 7 - 8): Home-based (full Virtual) for students and parents who selected this option. Homeroom (Hybrid) for students and parents who selected this option will continue on hybrid. Beginning the week of March 22nd, DCS will offer in-person learning a minimum of 20 hours per week to all K-12 students who choose that option, subject to administrative confidence to find it possible.

High School (Grades 9 - 12): Home-based (full Virtual) for students and parents who selected this option. Homeroom (Hybrid) for students and parents who selected this option will continue on hybrid. Beginning the week of March 22nd, DCS will offer in-person learning a minimum of 20 hours per week to all K-12 students who choose that option, subject to administrative confidence that it's possible.
