## Daniel Breeden Elementary Re-Opening Plans 2020-2021



### Reopening Tentative Timelines 2020-2021

- Will adhere to BISD tentative timelines for reopening of Breeden Elementary.
  - Slowed phased in for face to face instruction for students not having electronic device and/or internet.
  - Data used is from survey commitment plan, teacher contact and school contact with parents.



### School Closure Protocol

- Should superintendent of schools order campus closed due to a confirmed COVID-19 case, At Home Learning or via remote instruction will continue to the extent it is possible to do so beginning the following day.
- Breeden Elementary teachers will follow plan to transition to At Home Learning or via remote instruction; students were given electronic device if requested by parent/guardian.
- Communication will be sent to ALL parents and staff notifying them of a confirmed case (TEA letter).
- Campus administration will notify human resources of a confirmed case.
- Breeden custodians will utilize the Clorox Deep Cleaning machine as well as deep clearing procedures for disinfecting the heavily used areas used by the individual with the test confirmed case.
- Campus closure will range from 1 to 3 days maximum.



#### **Campus Visitor Protocol**

- Non-essential visitors will not be allowed in the building.
- Temperature checks will be conducted for all visitors entering the building.
- All visitors who can enter the building will be required to wear a face covering. Visitors may be asked to momentarily remove a face covering to verify identification.
- All visitors will be screened using the BISD Health Screening Form. When asking individuals if they have symptoms for COVID-19, school will only require the individual to provide a "Yes" or "No" to the overall statement that they are symptomatic for COVID-19.
- A visitor who has tested positive for COVID-19 will not be allowed in school buildings until they have met the criteria for reentry in accordance to Center for Disease Control (CDC) Guidelines.



#### Campus Visitor Protocol Continues . . .

- Social distancing will be maintained for any meeting with a visitor (ARD, etc.).
- Breeden Elementary will not accept non-essential deliveries (including meal deliveries, birthday cakes, flowers) during the school day. During substantial and moderate COVID-19 activity, Breeden Elementary will restrict visitors inside the building, including volunteers and parents.



### Disinfecting & Hand Sanitizing Protocol

- Staff will receive COVID-19 training, including hand-washing procedures, the use
  of personal protective equipment, sanitation procedures, and safe glove removal
  procedures.
- Students will receive hand-washing training, face covering training, safe glove removal, and sanitation procedures training on the first day of instruction.
- Breeden Elementary will have hand sanitizer at each entrance. Every classroom at Breeden has a hand sanitizer including, in the cafeteria and in common areas throughout the campus such as teacher's lounge, library, etc.
- Students, teachers, staff, and campus visitors are encouraged to sanitize and/or wash hands frequently.
- Breeden Elementary students will wash their hands before going to lunch.
- Every classroom at Breeden Elementary has a sanitizing station as you enter the classroom. Students are expected to use hand sanitizer every time they enter classroom.



# Disinfecting & Hand Sanitizing Protocol Continues . . .

- Breeden Elementary teachers will embed in lesson plans good handwashing techniques.
- PK3 Kinder teacher aides will assist teacher in wiping down desks at the end of the day.
- 1<sup>st</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> –Students will be asked to wipe down their desks at the end of the day.
- All students will have a desk shield on desk or table.
- All students will be wearing face mask at all times, except while eating.
- PK3-3<sup>rd</sup> Grade students will be provided a face shield.
- Desks and/or tables are socially distanced as much as instructionally possible.
- Teachers will keep a seating chart and will practice bubble groups when possible.
- Teachers will eliminate communal supplies when possible. Shared supplies will be sanitized between use.
- Breeden Elementary has removed all non-essential items such as bean bags, extra tables, etc.
- Teachers will post their teacher/student cleaning classroom procedures.
- Students' individual needs will be addressed on a case-by-case basis.



# Disinfecting & Hand Sanitizing Protocol Continues . . .

- Teachers will consider assigning cohorts of students specific manipulatives in order to reduce the possibility of exposure or consider creating individual bags of supplementary aids and/or manipulatives for student use that could also be sent home in the event of school closure.
- The use of outdoor space for learning will be considered when possible. Classroom groups working outside will maintain at least 12 feet of social distance from other classroom groups.
- Whenever possible, students and staff will maintain consistent groupings of people to minimize the spread of the virus. Fourth and fifth grade teachers will move classroom for transitions in instruction and students will remain in their homeroom class.



# Disinfecting & Hand Sanitizing Protocol Continues . . .

- Campus has
  - Directional arrows
  - Signage for handwashing, maintain social distance, etc.
  - Campus lounge has maximum occupancy of 6 people
  - Student restroom has maximum occupancy of 2
  - Additional sinks have been covered temporarily to maintain social distance
  - All water fountains have been covered temporarily
  - All entrance and exit signs are identified/labeled
  - Holding room is identified
  - Extra PPE and cleaning supplies have been ordered
  - Faculty meetings will be ongoing to provide and remind the Reopening procedures of campus and district wide.
